The museum also showcases Schwalm country furniture that dates back many centuries. A number of exhibition rooms authentically show you what life was like in the Schwalm region in the period before 1900. The white embroidery typical of the Schwalm region is given particular focus. The history of Ziegenhain Castle is depicted using a handmade, several square metres large model, as well as original weaponry from the period of the Thirty Year War. Our extensive collection of exhibits from the Stone Age, which were found in various sites in the Schwalm region, is also sure to fascinate visitors. Those who appreciate Schwalm paintings can enjoy a rich and unique selection of paintings from the Willingshausen painters' colony.

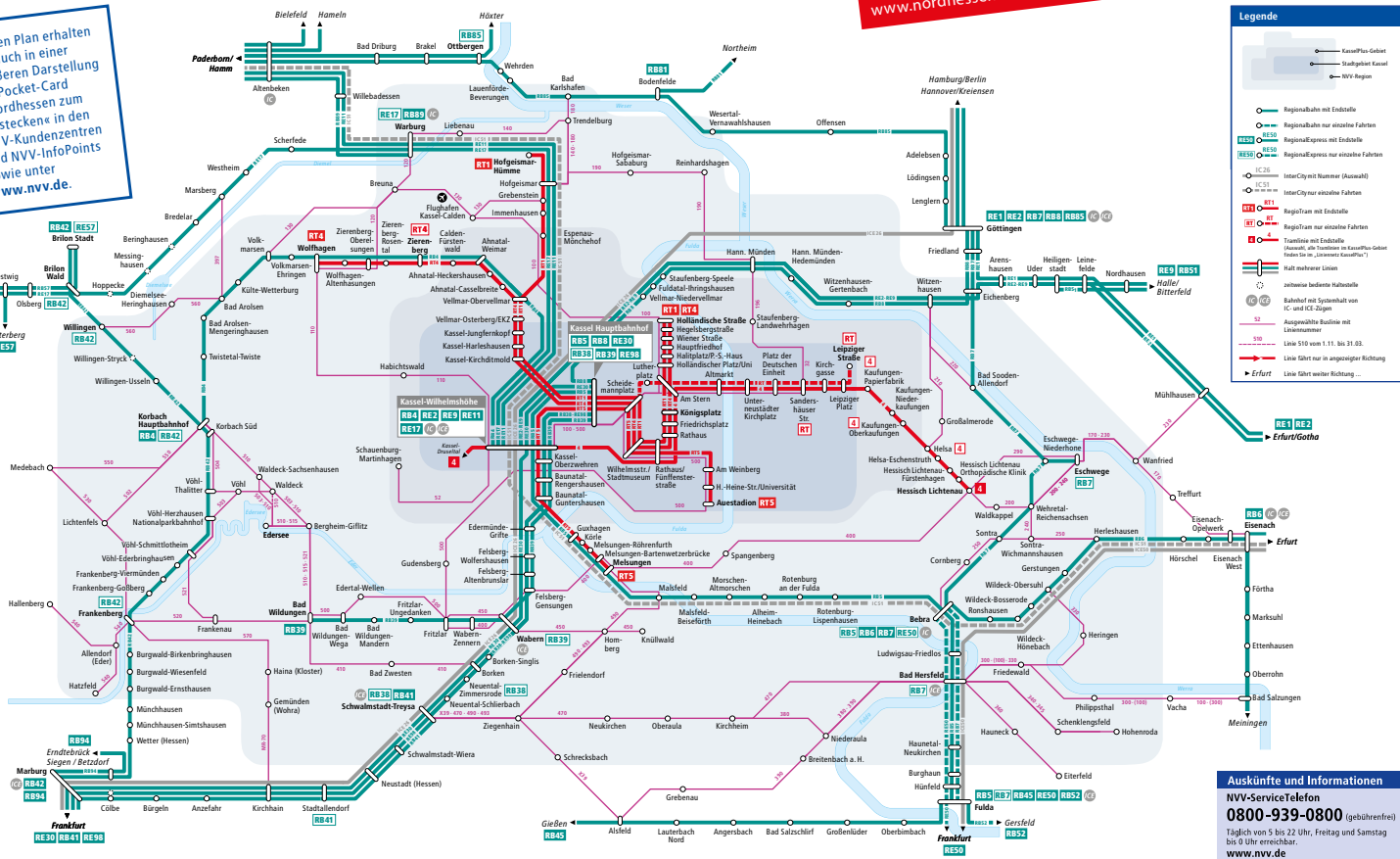

Terms and Conditions

Dear Guests,

With the services covered by the MEINECARDPLUS GUEST CARD, the participating accommodation providers and private landlords, the respective service partners and the localities and regions in the home of the Brothers Grimm in North Hesse offer you special services and benefits to make your stay a special experience. Clear agreements about reciprocal rights and obligations, which we would like to enter into with you in the form of the following terms and conditions governing card use, also contribute to this. Please read these terms and conditions carefully before accepting MEINECARDPLUS and availing yourself of the services.

1. Definitions, Participants, Subject of These Terms and Conditions Governing Card Use

1.1. Issuer of the GUEST CARD and contractual partner in the contract governing card use entered into with the card holder is Regionalmanagement Nordhessen GmbH, Ständeplatz 13, 34117 Kassel, hereinafter referred to as „RMN“.

1.2. These terms and conditions governing card use shall lay down the conditions of use of MEINECARDPLUS/ MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL itself as well as the contract and service relationship with the service partners, supplementing, in this respect, any additional agreements to be made by the card holders with the service partners.

1.3. Service partners, and hence providers of the services promised, in each case, by means of the GUEST CARD, shall be those leisure establishments like institutions, companies, transport companies, associations, self-employed persons, tradesmen and establishments that render the respective services to the card holder (hereinafter referred to as „Service Partners“). They shall be named as Service Partners in the currently applicable list of services for MEINECARDPLUS/MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL.

1.4. Service Partners, service providers/ providers of the services promised by means of the GUEST CARD shall be neither RMN nor the hosts, unless the latter's own range of services is involved.

1.5. The term „MEINECARDPLUS“ shall hereinafter refer to the version of the GUEST CARD IN PAPER FORM, which the guest receives from his or her host free of charge.

1.6. The term „MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL“ shall hereinafter refer to MEINECARDPLUS in the form of an additional digital card, which the card holder can activate and use via the website www.grimmheimat.de. On receipt of MEINECARDPLUS in the form of the paper card, the card holder may activate the MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL free of charge via the website www.grimmheimat.de. The card holder can then use the MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL via this website in addition to and in parallel with use of MEINECARDPLUS in paper form.

1.7. The term „GUEST CARD“ shall hereinafter refer to both MEINECARDPLUS and MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL.

1.8. „Host“ shall hereinafter refer to the commercial accommodation providers, holiday apartment landlords and private landlords that participate in the GUEST CARD programme and issue MEINECARDPLUS to the guest.

1.9. The guest who receives the GUEST CARD from his or her Host and in whose name the card is issued shall hereinafter be referred to as the „Card Holder“. The guest shall be entitled to avail himself or herself of the services promised by means of the GUEST CARD.

1.10. All the guests of the participating Host shall be entitled to use the card. Accompanying children up to the age of 3 shall receive the card services from the Service Partner free of charge if the adult chaperone of the child/ children provides evidence of his or her right of usage as the Card Holder. Relatives of the owners of hosts and their families shall not be entitled to use the card if they are registered as having their primary residence in the same household.

1.11. The „Service Period“ of the GUEST CARD shall extend to the complete duration of the guest's stay at the Host. The validity of the GUEST CARD shall be limited to the days of usage (0 to 24 hours) per overnight accommodation. This shall commence on issuance of the card by the Host on the day of arrival and cease at midnight on the day of departure.

2. Legal Bases, Service Partners' Performance Obligations, Relationship of Card Services with Other Services Provided by the Service Partners, Information and Third-Party Representations

2.1. The issuance and use of the GUEST CARD shall not give rise to any contractual obligation between the Card Holder and the Hosts or RMN in relation to the services of the Service Partners themselves.

The Host itself shall have no performance obligation vis-à-vis the Card Holder with regard to the services provided by the Service Partners, neither as a primary contractual obligation, nor as an ancillary contractual obligation. The same shall apply to RMN as the issuer of the GUEST CARD. In particular, the Host and RMN shall not have the status of a package holiday operator or travel agent. Use of the card shall not affect the contractual relationship between the Card Holder as a guest of the Host and the agreements entered into with the latter in respect of utilization of the accommodation and other services.

2.2. The contract with the Card Holder in respect of the service shall be formed with the respective provider of the service (Service Partner). All the Service Partners shall be detailed in the list of services for the GUEST CARD, the so-called „Leisure Guide“, which the Card Holder will receive from the Host when the GUEST CARD is handed over and which can be downloaded from the website: <http://www.MEINECARDPLUS.de>. Only the respective Service Partner shall be obliged to render the respective service vis-à-vis the Card Holder, not RMN or the Host, unless their own services are involved.

2.3. The contractual partner with regard to the services shall be solely the respective Service Partner as provider. RMN and the Host shall have no obligations to perform or to provide information with regard to services covered by the GUEST CARD, save where the Host itself is also a Service Partner. RMN and the Host shall not be liable for information regarding services and prices, the services themselves or for personal injury or material damage sustained in connection with provision of the services.

2.4. In addition to these terms and conditions governing card use, the terms and conditions of business and/ or terms and conditions of service/ carriage of the Service Partner as provider and the statutory provisions applicable to the respective service relationship shall, where effectively agreed or generally applicable in accordance with statutory provisions, also apply to the contract and service relationship between the Card Holder and the Service Partner in respect of the services promised by means of the GUEST CARD.

2.5. The services promised by means of MEINECARDPLUS and MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL in accordance with the current list of services shall not be a primary tourist service in the context of other contractual services provided by the Host or RMN. Accordingly, neither the Host nor RMN shall have the status of a package holiday organizer under the statutory provisions in relation to the card services, except in cases in which the services are presented together with other services of the Host as a complete set of travel services in accordance with the principles set out in section 651a (2) of the Bürgerliches Gesetzbuch (German Civil Code - BGB) or are expressly offered in this way by the provider.

2.6. The Hosts shall not be authorized by RMN to enter into any agreements that diverge from these terms and conditions of use or to provide information or make representations that diverge from the currently applicable list of services covered by the guest card, are in conflict with it or go beyond it. The same shall apply to the Service Partners, save where the information, divergent agreement or representation refers to their own service.

3. Formation of the Contract Governing Card Use, Card Issue, Free-of-Charge Nature

3.1. By offering to actually issue MEINECARDPLUS in paper form, RMN, represented by the Hosts, shall make the Card Holder a binding offer to enter into the contract governing card use on the basis of these terms and conditions and the currently applicable list of services. The contract governing card use entered into with the Card Holder on the basis of these terms and conditions of use shall be formed when the Card Holder takes receipt of MEINECARDPLUS. By taking receipt of MEINECARDPLUS, the Card Holder shall accept these terms and conditions governing card use.

3.2. RMN, as the issuer of the GUEST CARD, shall organize and manage only the card system and oblige the affiliated Service Partners to provide the service to the Card Holder.

In addition to MEINECARDPLUS in paper form, the Card Holder may use MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL (see 1.6). The barcode on MEINECARDPLUS and MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL provides up-to-date information, in each case, about data stored on the GUEST CARD, such as places already visited, first and last name, card number as well as date of arrival and departure and, where applicable, fellow travellers.

3.3. Both MEINECARDPLUS and MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL shall be free of charge to the Card Holders.

4. MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL – Card Activation via the WEBSITE www.grimmheimat.de, Duties of Care of the MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL Card Holder.

4.1. Use of MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL shall be conditional upon the registration via the website www.grimmheimat.de and under provision of the required information.

4.2. There shall be no entitlement to activation of MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL. The Card Holder may use MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL only if he or she has previously accepted the terms and conditions governing card use on receipt of MEINECARDPLUS. The Card Holder's attention shall again be drawn to these terms and conditions governing card use in the context of activation of MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL on the website www.grimmheimat.de.

4.3 The Card Holder shall be obliged to use his or her full first and last name (real name) as well as his or her MEINECARDPLUS card number for registration during activation. It must be possible for RMN, as the provider of website, to identify the user's true person. The real name shall not be visible to other users or third parties. (Each Card Holder may, however, also display, in the app, accompanying members of his or her family/group with their own cards.) We also draw the user's attention to the website's data protection provisions, which the user accepts on activation of MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL on the website.

4.4. The provider of the Website app shall accept no liability for the content made available on the website being accurate, complete or up to data at all times.

4.5. The Card Holder shall not be allowed to make his or her personal access to MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL available for third parties to use. He or she shall be obliged to keep his or her access data and card number secret and to protect them against third-party access (except that of accompanying guests).

4.6. The Card Holder may terminate his or her activation without notice by withdrawing the declaration of consent in the login area. This will delete the user data for MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL and the functionality of the MEINECARDPLUS expires. Irrespective of this, the Card Holder may continue to use MEINECARDPLUS in paper form.

4.7. On expiry of the service period of MEINECARDPLUS, access to MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL on the website shall automatically expire. The user will no longer be able to log in, with the user data for MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL being deleted.

4.8. If there is good cause, such as in the event of a gross breach of these terms and conditions governing card use, RMN, as the provider, shall be entitled to block the Card Holder's access to the MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL immediately without giving any notice.

4.9. Adjusting or changing to the WEBSITE MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL.

4.9.1. RMN shall be entitled to make changes to the WEBSITE MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL at any time.

4.9.2. RMN shall be entitled to terminate its service in respect of the MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL, subject to a notice period of two weeks. In the event of termination of the MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL, RMN shall be entitled, but not obliged, to delete all content created by users.

5. Nature and Scope of Services and Restrictions Thereof, Exclusion from Use, Period of Validity of the Guest Card

5.1. On issuance of MEINECARDPLUS, the Card Holder may avail himself or herself of the services in the currently applicable list of services covered by the GUEST CARD. The nature and scope of the services for the Card Holder shall be derived exclusively from the list of services applicable at the time the card is issued, which list shall be handed over to the Card Holder together with MEINECARDPLUS or be generally advertised or publicized.

5.2. Service Partners shall be obliged to provide services only as stipulated by the general terms and conditions of their business activity, particularly taking into account advertised service periods, opening times and general conditions of service provision (e.g. weather-related conditions).

5.3. Where the services covered by the GUEST CARD are also described in other advertising materials (Host lists, prospectuses, catalogues, websites) outside the currently applicable list of services for the free GUEST CARD, the Card Holder's utilization of these services shall be governed exclusively by the service description in the currently applicable list of services for the GUEST CARD. This shall apply, in particular, if the description in the list of services for the guest card differs from other such service descriptions.

5.4. Service Partners may restrict advertised services in whole or in part, particularly in terms of time, if there are objective reasons for them to do so. This shall particularly include impediments to performance due to weather conditions, official stipulations or orders, maintenance and repair work, traffic safety measures, excessive numbers of visitors or overcrowding of facilities as well as other similar objective reasons.

5.5. RMN, as the issuer, and Service Partners may exclude Card Holders and other authorized users from using the services wholly or partly, temporarily or permanently if they fail to meet particular personal requirements (e.g. health requirements or requirements in respect of clothing and equipment) and if use in a concrete situation poses a threat to the Card Holder, third parties or the Service Partner's facilities. The same shall apply if the Card Holder, in the course of use, breaches statutory provisions, safety regulations, rules of use or instructions by supervisors or is otherwise in breach of the contract to such an extent that exclusion is objectively warranted.

5.6. In the event of a restriction of services in accordance with 5.4. or 5.5. or a justified exclusion in accordance with 5.5., the GUEST CARD holder shall not be entitled to file any claims.

5.7. The Card Holder may avail himself or herself of the services covered by the guest card in accordance with 1.11 only during a stay at a participating Host in the guest card's area of validity. The Card Holder shall not be entitled to transfer the guest card and/or its services to future stays or other persons.

6. Use of the GUEST CARD, Card Owner's Obligations and Liability

6.1. In order to avail himself or herself of a service, the Card Holder shall be obliged to present the original MEINECARDPLUS in paper form or to display MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL on a terminal and to enable the Service Partner to carry out an electronic or visual inspection prior to claiming the service.

6.2. Users of MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL shall independently ensure that the terminal has sufficient battery power in the event of an inspection.

6.3. Furthermore, the MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL Card Holder must independently ensure that his or her terminal has Internet access. Only then will he or she be able to display MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL on his or her terminal to enable it to be inspected prior to utilization of the services. If he or she is technically unable to do so, the Service Partner may refuse to provide the service. This shall also apply in the event of a defective terminal or in the event that no Internet access is possible due to regional conditions. Service Partners shall not be obliged to enable Card Holders to use WI-FI or terminals. RMN therefore also recommends Card Holders to carry MEINECARDPLUS in paper form with them.

6.4. The Card Holder shall be obliged to present valid photo identification on request. If he or she is unable to do so, the Service Partner may refuse to provide the service. In the case of age-related services and benefits for the Card Holder or his or her authorized family members, the Service Partner may demand relevant proof of age.

6.5. If the guest card is stolen, lost or becomes defective, the Card Holder shall be obliged to report this incident immediately to the Host to enable the Host to block this GUEST CARD. The Card Holder shall then receive a new GUEST CARD for the service period free of charge from the Host.

6.6. The Card Holder shall be liable to RMN/ the Host and the Service Partners for any damage arising from misuse of the GUEST CARD by him or her or third parties which he or she has culpably caused or co-caused.

6.7. In the event of misuse or suspected misuse, the Service Partners shall be entitled to take a note of the MEINECARDPLUS card number as well as first and last name and to forward them to RMN with a view to prompting RMN to block the GUEST CARD.

6.8. If the Card Holder suspects third parties of misusing the GUEST CARD, he or she shall be obliged to notify his or her Host immediately thereof.

6.9. The guest card shall not include any insurance services. It shall be incumbent upon the Card Holder to check and ensure his or her own insurance cover, particularly in respect of accidents in connection with utilization of the card services and in respect of cover for repatriation costs in the event of accident or illness.

6.10. It shall be incumbent upon the Card Holder to check and ensure that he or she is personally suitable and that prerequisites, particularly in terms of health and in relation to official regulations, upon which utilization of the card services is conditional have been met.

7. RMN's Technical Obligations

7.1. RMN is at pains to keep the technical system behind the GUEST CARD available at all times. The Card Holder shall, however, not be entitled to constant availability of the service, such as the WEBSITE MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL. Maintenance work may result in the service (barcode on the GUEST CARD) and the WEBSITE MEINECARDPLUS DIGITAL being temporarily inaccessible. RMN recommends the Card Holder to carry MEINECARDPLUS in paper form by way of supplement with him or her.

7.2. Owing to the structure of the Internet, RMN has no control over data transmission on the Internet and accepts no responsibility for the availability, reliability and quality of telecommunications networks, data networks or technical facilities of third parties outside its own communications network. RMN shall not be responsible for faults due to force majeure.

7.3. RMN shall not be liable for the safety and existence of data communications that are conducted via communication networks of third parties, such as Internet providers, or for faults in data transmission that arise due to technical errors or configuration problems on the part of the Card Holder.

8. Dispute Resolution

8.1. The European Commission makes a platform available for out-of-court dispute resolution (Art. 14(1) of the ODR Regulation). This makes it possible for consumers to arrive at an initial settlement of disputes without involving a court. 9. Reservation of the Right to Make Amendments with Regard to Card Services and Terms and Conditions Governing Card Use

9.1. RMN, as the issuer of the GUEST CARD, and the Service Providers, as providers of the services, reserve the right to amend these terms and conditions governing card use and the list of services from time to time on objective grounds and to adapt these documents to technical and legal developments.

9.2. The version of the terms and conditions governing card use and of the list of services published at the time MEINECARDPLUS is issued shall apply to the Card Holder. Amendments after MEINECARDPLUS has been issued shall be excluded for the period of validity applicable to the respective Card Owner if such amendments are disadvantageous to him or her.

9.3. Over and above that, reservations of the right to make amendments shall depend on the terms and conditions of business of the Service Partners as providers, providing the latter have been agreed with legal effect and contain valid provisions in this respect; otherwise, the statutory provisions shall apply.

10. Choice of Law

10.1. The entire legal and contractual relationship between RMN and the Card Holder in the context of the contract governing card use and between the Card Holder and the Service Partner in the context of the contract and usage relationship in respect of the respective services shall be governed exclusively by the law of the Federal Republic of Germany.

10.2. The choice of law under 10.1 shall not affect mandatory consumer protection regulations of the EU country in which a Card Holder as a consumer from a different EU country has his or her ordinary residence.
